ADULT EDUCATION DURING THE GREAT FAST

SUNDAY MORNINGS Beginning Sunday, March 5, and continuing until Sunday, March 26, St Mary parishioner, Christian Gonzalez, will be offering adult education classes in the meeting room of the parish office between the two Liturgies on Sunday mornings, from approximately 9:45 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

FRIDAY LENTEN LUNCH AND LEARNING! We will have special speakers on the first four Fridays of the Great Fast in the parish center. We will begin with a Moleben at 12 noon in the church and then go to the parish center for a special speaker, accompanied by a Lenten lunch of soup and bread. These will be on the first four Fridays of the Fast: February 24, March 3, March 10, and March 17. A free-will offering will be taken up to defray the cost of the food.

FASTING RULES FOR THE GREAT FAST 2023

All Byzantine Catholics are obliged Wednesdays and Fridays of the Great Fast, all Byzantine Catholics are obliged to abstain from meat and products but permitting the use of eggs and dairy products. Please speak to Father Jim if you need a dispensation for a serious reason. This is the minimum required; additional fasting is encouraged.

LITURGICAL NOTES During the Great Fast, we do not celebrate the Divine Liturgy on weekdays. This includes Funeral Divine Liturgies. For funerals, the body will be brought into church and the funeral service without the Divine Liturgy will be celebrated. Since every celebration of the Divine Liturgy is a participation in the Resurrection of Our Lord, we abstain from it. Instead, we celebrate the Pre-Sanctified Liturgy on Wednesdays and Fridays.
